PLEASE READ

PERSON(S) RESPONSIBLE

The Person(s) responsible (PR) for a horse must be an adult who has, or shares responsibility for the care, training, custody, and performance of the horse and who has official responsibility for that horse under EC Rules. The PR is liable under the penalty provisions of the applicable EC Rules for any rule violations. Every entry form for an EC sanctioned competition must identify the PR & be signed by the PR. The Person(s) responsible is ultimately responsible for the condition, fitness and management of the horse and is alone responsible for any act performed by himself/herself or by any other person with authorized access to the horse in the stables, elsewhere on the grounds, or while the horse is being ridden, driven or exercised. A602.7

A: For adult entries into EC sanctioned competitions the PR shall be either the trainer, the owner of the horse of the competitor who rides or drives the horse during the EC sanctioned competition. Section A Page 101

B: For Junior entries into EC sanctioned competitions the Junior competitor cannot be the PR. For Junior entries the PR may be either the trainer, the owner of the horse, or a parent/guardian of the Junior competition Per Article A801 -- every entry at an EC-sanctioned competition shall constitute an agreement by the person responsible that the owner, lessee, trainer, manager, agent, coach, driver or rider and horse shall be subject to the EC constitution and all rules of EC and any additional rules set by the competition.

STATEMENT OF PRINCIPLE

The Equestrian Canada Federation (EC), the National Federation of Canada, supports adherence to humane treatment of horses in all competitions under its jurisdiction.

EC is committed to:

- Upholding the welfare of horses, regardless of value, as a primary consideration in all activities.
- Requiring that horses be treated with kindness, respect, and the compassion that they deserve, and that they never be subjected to mistreatment.
 Ensuring that owners, trainers, exhibitors and their agents use responsible care in the handling, treatment and transportation of their horses as well
- as horses placed under their care for any purpose.
 Providing for the continuous well-being of horses by encouraging routine inspection and consultation with health care professionals and competition officials to achieve the highest possible standards of nutrition, health, comfort, sanitation and safety as a matter of standard operating procedure.
- Continuing to support scientific studies on equine health and welfare.
- Increasing education in training and horsemanship practices.
- Requiring owners, trainers and exhibitors to know and follow their sanctioning organization is rules and to work within industry regulations in all
 equestrian competitions.
- Reviewing, revising and developing competition rules and regulations that protect the welfare of horses.

The standard by which conduct or treatment will be measured is that which a person/**person responsible**, informed and experienced in generally accepted equine training and exhibition procedures, would determine to be neither cruel, abusive nor inhumane. Neither the Parkland Spring Horse Show Committee nor the Management or Owner of the Westerner Park nor any of its staff or agents shall be in any way liable for any accident, injury, damage, loss, or for any other matter that may happen, from any cause or circumstances whatsoever, to exhibitors competitors, or members or their agents or to anyone on the show grounds or to any animal or article exhibited or to any property brought on the show grounds or for any loss, claim, matter, circumstances or event whatsoever in connection with, arising out of, or attributable to the show or any journey to or from the show. It is to be understood and agreed that under no circumstances shall Parkland or Westerner Park its owner, agents or employees be liable for any loss, damages claims or costs occasioned or suffered by an exhibitor, competitor or their agents directly or indirectly howsoever arising, including without limitation, losses, damages, claims or costs as a result of Parkland or Westerner Park its owners, agents or employees negligence and you agree to indemnify and save harmless Parkland or Westerner Park is owners, agents any liability arising out of any such loss, damages, claims or costs. **The Show** Committee reserves the right to add, amend, or delete any point not covered by the rules and to correct any error or make any necessary changes in the Prize List or Program.

Membership to EC is now called a "Sport License". All exhibitors, owners, trainers, riders, drivers, handlers **must** join EC with a <u>sport license</u> to be able to compete in any EC sanctioned show. Memberships to Equestrian Canada for ARABIAN or HA/AA one owner, all exhibitors, riders, drivers, trainers MUST purchase an Alberta Equestrian Federation membership separately if you live in Alberta or the provincial equivalent if from any other province in Canada.

SAFE SPORT COURSES - All Senior EC Sport License holders must complete two Safe Sport modules at no cost and valid for a three-year period. All USEF Competitors will need to complete two Safe Sport modules also at no cost using their USEF membership.

EC COACH STATUS 2025

EC Coach Status Section A, General Regulations, Article 102, Safe Sport Environments Effective July 1, 2023, Canadian residents coaching athletes at EC-sanctioned events must meet minimum EC Coach Status requirements:

- Temporary Coach Status is now to be purchased directly from EC via the MyEC Portal.
- Competitions must ensure all coaches named on entry hold either EC Licensed Coach Status OR have purchased Temporary
 Coach Status from EC.
- Temporary Coach status can be validated via the Competition Support Portal of the event.
- This means no more paper forms to be collected from the coach on-site.

Temporary Coach Status will be available until December 31, 2025; after this time, coaches at all EC-sanctioned events must meet Licensed Coach Status requirements.

When registering for EC sanctioned competitions, athletes must indicate the name of their coach on the entry form or specify that they are self-coached. Coaches from other countries, must be in good-standing with their home federation and must declare/have proof of insurance. See Rules of Equestrian Canada, Section A, General Regulations. AHA Membership Statement - AHA Comp 301.10

Each competitor (this includes at least one recorded owner and all trainers, drivers, riders, halter handlers, coaches and the person(s) and signing the entry blank in an Arabian Horse Association recognized Arabian division, at the time of entry into a competition, must submit a copy of a valid AHA membership or competition card, join AHA or pay an AHA single membership fee for competitor. When an agent signs for the owner at an AHA recognized competition, both the owner and the agent must be members of AHA or pay the AHA single event membership. Single event membership is not acceptable at AHA Regional or National competitions. Exhibitors in Walk/Trot classes are exempt from AHA membership requirements at qualifying competitions, but must have an AHA membership with competition card at AHA Regional and National Competitions.

Exhibitors in Lead Line classes or Parents/Guardians signing for minors are exempt from AHA membership requirements.

Rules and Regulations

These shows are conducted in accordance with the rules of EC and AHA. Each participant in this show is responsible for knowledge of the rules and is subject to these rules. Any changes or corrections will automatically become part of this Prize List. Questions that arise, that are not covered by either AHA or EC rulebooks, will be decided by the Parkland Show Committee and their decisions will be final.

General Rules

1. All entries must:

- ✓ have <u>each owner's</u> entry on a separate form;
- ✓ full address of owner (plus that of the trainer and/or authorized agent);
- ✓ signature of owner (plus that of the trainer or authorized agent) or the adult and person responsible ;
- ✓ copies of all membership cards, this includes AHA, CMHA, ASHAC, & EC & AEF (PSO)
- ✓ Amateur Owner / Rider and Junior Exhibitor cards;
- ✓ a copy of each horse's registration papers (front and back);
- ✓ include funds to cover entry, stall rental, drug fees and all required fees shown on entry form.
- 2. All E-transfers, cheques, money orders or drafts are to be made payable to the Parkland Arabian Horse Association. <u>No post-dated cheques</u> will be accepted for Entry Fees, Stabling, Sponsorships or Advertising.
- 3. Horses entering any classes (except those listed as All Breeds) must be registered with the Canadian Arabian Horse Registry (CAHR), the Arabian Horse Registry of America or the AHA or the Canadian Morgan Horse Association (CMHA); the American Saddlebred Horse Association of Canada (ASHAC); or any other duly recognized registry if the horse is owned by a citizen of a foreign country. For greater clarity, an American Saddlebred or Morgan owned by an American citizen may be entered with a name and registration number from the American Saddlebred Horse Association or the American Morgan Horse Association. Horses must be entered under their full registered name with their registration number, or if an age specified by breed rules, as eligible for registration. Horses must be entered under the name(s) of the owner or lessee of record with the breed association. A copy of the registration papers showing recorded ownership or proof of lease must be submitted with the entry form at the time the entry is made.
- 4. Post entries will be accepted at this show. However, "the per horse post-entry fee of \$25 and will accepted up to one full session prior.
- 5. Any horse entered in any class at a competition may be selected for equine medication control testing while at the event location." . A602.5
- 6. All Arabian sanctioned <u>AHA Shows</u> must collect a mandatory fee per horse entered per show of \$7.00 US funds converts to \$10.00 Canadian. This is in accordance to Resolution #9/90 that addressed mandatory funding for the new Judges, Commission and Education/Evaluation Committee. To compensate for the US exchange rate, the Parkland Spring Show will be charging \$10.00 CDN_per show to those entering horses in Arabian or Half/Arabian classes to cover this fee. This fee will be refunded to owners following the current vet out ruling per AHA Rules. AHA 602.5
- ARTICLE A1006 Examination Sample & Collect for drug testing by EC staff the recommendation of the chair or the chair's delegate, the technician or the licensed veterinarian may select for sample collection and testing of any horse entered in any class at an EC-sanctioned competition.
- 8. Management reserves the right to reject any entry at any time for any reason the Officials deem reasonable cause.
- 9. No entry fee will be refunded except on receipt of a Veterinarian's Certificate, which is required and must be presented to the Show Secretary. No refunds of entry fees for any reason after 8:00 am, Friday, May 16, 2025. A \$50 fee will be deducted from any refund to cover processing expenses. There is no substitution of horses for any reason unless approved by show management with extenuating circumstances. Show Secretary will also retain the office fee and back number fee.
- 10. A charge of \$50.00 will be levied for cheques returned by the bank for any reason. Exhibitors with returned cheques will not be allowed to show unless a certified cheque, cash or money order is presented to the Show Office prior to the start of classes on Friday, May 16, 2025 8:00am. This charge will also go for any credit card.
- 11. Management reserves the right to combine or cancel classes having fewer than 3 entries at closing of entries. Exhibitors will be notified if classes are cancelled due to low entries. All changes will be posted at the Show Office. Please verify your classes and fees on the Acknowledgement emailed to you.
- 12. Calls or emails will be made to exhibitors by the Show Secretary if deemed necessary to clarify any entry.
- 13. If entry forms <u>are not completely</u> correct they may be returned at the discretion of the Show Secretary. Entries missing priority items such as horse papers and copies of membership cards will be charged an additional <u>\$10.00 fee by the Show Secretary</u>.
- 14. Items missing from the entry form are asked to bring those items to the show office when they check in. It is alot of extra work to have them emailed, faxed or mailed prior to the show.
- 15. Entries must be post-marked or emailed , no later than midnight Sunday, April 20, 2025
- 16. Unrelated Owners In Owner Classes For the purpose of showing in Junior Owner and Amateur Owner classes,
 - two non-related owners will now be able to co-own a horse and show in owner classes provided that :
 - a. The Ownership must be an AND relationship not an OR relationship.
 - b. No family member of a professional may enter into this relationship.
 - c. "Non-family owners" are defined as two distinct individuals who are not related as family as defined by EC.
 - d. Family members of these two co-owners are **NOT** permitted to show in owner classes.
 - e. Both co-owners must be members of EC/USEF and hold a valid Amateur card. Refer to Equestrian Canada rules for more information!
- 17. Upon any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the Officials by an owner, groom, rider or driver, the owner may forfeit the entry fee and as such will be reported to the Horse Show Committee and/or EC and/or AHA. The Committee reserves the right to itself, the power to remove any groom, horse, rider, family member or persons associated with any horse or rider from the show grounds without being liable for compensation

General Rules Continued......

- 18. The Horse Show Committee reserves the right to decide on any point not governed by the rules to correct any error or make any necessary alterations to the Rules, Prize List or Program.
- 19.. Barn calls are a courtesy only. Exhibitors <u>must</u> check in with the Gate Attendant <u>before</u> the class is called to enter the ring. Those exhibitors who have not checked in, may be stopped from entering the ring. Exhibitors must enter the ring promptly when called. The gate will close 2 minutes after the first horse enters the ring or in cases with large classes taking more than 2 minutes, after the entry of the final horse in a continuous string of horses. Those not ready when called will not be allowed to enter the ring once the gate is closed.
- 20. Gate holds will be granted at the discretion of Show Management and <u>must be</u> requested through the Show Office <u>well before</u> the class, <u>preferably before the beginning of the session prior to</u> requiring the gate hold.
- 21. No person other than Officials, the Steward and Attendants on duty may enter the Show Ring without permission of the Horse Show Committee.
- 22. Grooms entering the ring are required to be neatly attired.
- 23. Any exhibitor using the wrong number, or having no number in the ring may be excused from the class. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure that they are wearing the correct number in the class. Competition numbers must be worn & visible at all times. Please come to the show office to get a duplicate number if required.
- 24. Cruelty to or abuse of any horses by any person at a recognized show is forbidden. Excessive use of a whip on any horse anywhere on the show grounds before or during the show by any person constitutes a violation and renders the offender subject to penalty.
- 25. If any exhibitor has an outstanding debt to the Parkland Arabian Horse Assoc., the Show Committee reserves the right to refuse entry to the Show.

26. All dogs must be kept on a leash on the show grounds. <u>Dogs are NOT allowed in the Agricentre Pavillion</u> or hitching ring at any time.

27. Bikes/Scooters/ Skate Boards are <u>NOT</u> to be ridden in the Barns or around the hitching ring area at any time!.

28. Westerner Park has a <u>campground</u> that is operated independently. You may be asked to pay a fee if you have a trailer parked near the barn that appears to have living quarters, even if it is NOT plugged in. You may also be asked to move your trailer if it is parked at a barn & not plugged in.contact at <u>westernercampground.com</u> to prebook your RV/HorseTrailer with living quarters or 403-352-8801.

29. AGE SPLITS: Age Splits for AHA Junior Classes will be 14yrs & Under and 15-18years.

Membership

 All exhibitors entering Arabian and/or Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabian classes at this show must hold a valid AHA Competition membership or pay a Single Event Membership fee of \$35.00 person per show. This includes one owner, any trainer, driver, rider or halter handler who exhibits horses in the show ring or signs the entry form as the responsible person for any individual's horse. Walk/Trot exhibitors (not in showmanship)- but MUST have a provincial membership and Parents or Guardians signing the form for minors.

Lead Line Membership: All lead Line entries must have an AEF membership – No Fee – and put in the entry for that class along with all other paperwork. Membership Form will be separate on this show website - www.showsecretary.ca.

 One owner, and all drivers, riders, lessees, agents or trainers must hold an EC Sport License and have paid an appropriate provincial horse federation levy or if a US citizen holds a valid US Equestrian Federation membership. This show requires full Equestrian Canada Sport License for Arabian, Morgan & American Saddlebred exhibitors, owners, riders, drivers, handlers etc. along with the PSO – i.e. AEF for Alberta participants.

All Breed entries require EC Sport Horse License to exhibit for insurance purposes as they are EC approved classes.

- 3. <u>Amateur status</u> designation on an <u>EC Sport Horse License</u> is required for individuals wishing to exhibit in Amateur classes. You MUST apply for this card at the same time you apply for the Sport Horse License. No extra fee will be charged for Amateur Status. An Amateur is a person who, having attained the age of 19 (for show purpose) does not attempt to make a profit through equestrian activities; whose main source of income is not derived from equestrian activities which would make him/her professional. Amateur Owner is included in the Senior Competitive License fee but must be applied for at an additional fee within a Competitive License. *Check current EC rules for changes* A207
- 4.. You are cordially invited to join Equestrian Canada check fees in the Current rule book as they may have changed (plus provincial levy on each membership and Amateur Status) Amateur status must be applied for and is included in your Sport Horse License at no fee. Alberta residents MUST purchase an AEF membership plus EC Sport License to show at all Arabian & HA/AA shows Please refer to the EC Rules for Membership changes. The Parkland Spring Show is "Bronze" recognized shows for Arabian, Morgan, ASB and All Breeds.

A Single Event EC Sport License <u>upgrade</u> is for a competitor arriving at a competition without the correct EC Sport License level. The competitor pays a fee of \$20 to the competition to upgrade and compete at each level higher than their current license. The upgrade is valid only for that competition and does not accrue points. - 5. For the Arabian Division, Junior Horses are 5yrs and under as of January 1 of the current year. For Morgan and American Saddlebred classes, Junior Horses are 4yrs and under as of January 1, of the current year. Other breeds as per their rules and regulations.
- Arabian/HA/AA Individuals are AHA Junior Exhibitors if they have <u>not yet</u> reached their 19th birthday prior to December 1st of the previous calendar year. Individuals are Juniors, according to EC, until the end of the calendar year in which they reach 18yrs of age i.e. JOTR, JTR -18 & Under and AATR, AAOTR– are 19yrs & Over
- ASB, AB or Morgan Youth Exhibitors are 21yrs of age or younger. Youth Exhibitors may show stallions, mares or geldings with the exception
 of the Arabian/HA/AA stallion halter/breeding classes. Walk/trot, jog exhibitors cannot cross enter into any class requiring a lope or canter
 and must be 11years or under. Refer to EC rules for definition of youth & owner
- 8. Breeding In-hand Arabian and Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabian classes will use the Arabian Scoring System per current AHA handbook. In Hand Arabian & HA/AA Judges' cards have been modified, see AHA 2024 Handbook
- Morgan Youth classes are open to exhibitors 21 years of age and under. Youth classes are judged in accordance with Open Classes and are open to stallions, mares and geldings. Youth Exhibitors in the Morgan Division <u>may</u> cross enter in all other Junior Exhibitor classes offered in each Show. Stallions are <u>prohibited</u> in Junior Exhibitor classes.
- 10. Participants in Morgan English Pleasure classes must wear Saddle Seat attire. Refer to B5602.2 for EC
- 11. Participants in All Breeds English Pleasure and Park must wear Saddle Seat attire.
- 12. Morgan Classic Pleasure horses may cross enter in all other Morgan English Pleasure and Pleasure Driving classes offered in each Show.
- Arabian Country English Pleasure <u>may not enter</u> Arabian English Pleasure or Arabian Pleasure Driving classes <u>at the same show</u>. All horses are eligible to enter the All Breeds English Pleasure classes.
- 14. Amateur designation includes Adult and Junior riders. Junior horses are as per breed specifications. Novice horses cannot have won more than 3 first place ribbons in the Division entered. <u>No qualifying class required</u>.

All Breed Western Pleasure horses will be asked to walk, jog and lope both ways of the ring and will be asked to back. Hunter Pleasure horses will be asked to walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring and may be asked to back. Extended gaits may be called for.

All Breeds English Pleasure classes (see Awards #2) are open to Arabian and Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabian English Pleasure and Country English Pleasure horses; Morgan English Pleasure and Classic Pleasure horses; American Saddlebred Park, Three-Gaited, Pleasure, and Country Pleasure horses; and to horses of any other breed that have an English Pleasure division that exhibits in Saddle Seat attire. Horses entered must conform to their respective breed specifications for shoeing and horse age designation for the divisions permitted to show in the All Breed classes. Amateur designation includes Adult and Junior riders. Junior horses are as per breed specifications. Novice horses cannot have won more than 3 first place ribbons in the Division entered. <u>No qualifying class required</u>. Horses <u>must</u> walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring.

All Breeds Equitation classes will be conducted according to EC general Articles pertaining to Equitation, Hunter Seat on the Flat and Saddle Seat Equitation.

All Breeds English Show Hack horses will be asked to walk, trot, canter (normal, collected and extended gaits) and hand gallop (collectively) both ways of the ring, and will be asked to back.

- 15. AHA Medal Class Specifications are now located in the EC/USEF Rulebook and are no longer required to be printed in the prize List. Please refer to the Arabian Division Chapter for rules & class specs.
 - AHA Medal classes with pattern must be held regardless of number of competitors. An AHA Medal class must have a minimum of three (3) competitors with proper appointments in order to have an AHA Medal awarded. - 21. Junior exhibitors may not show stallions in All Breed classes, showmanship or equitation. Refer to breed-specific classes for rules of each breed organization shall apply with respect to Junior competitors exhibiting stallions.
- 22.. EC Article A905.2 states that Junior competitors must wear proper fitting, approved protective headgear, with the safety harness correctly secured, at all times while mounted on competition or event grounds. Approved headgear meets the ASTM (American Society for testing Materials) standards and displays the SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) seal. The British standard, BSI, is also acceptable. EC Article A905.1 strongly recommends that all persons wear approved headgear at all times while mounted or driving cross country or marathon. However, at present, if a Junior is competing in a discipline or breed whose rules specify other headgear (e.g. western hats, derbies etc) those rules supersede the new rule. However, all breeds and disciplines do allow protective headgear with no penalty and we urge their members to put safety ahead of tradition and adopt the new rule. Therefore, no helmets are mandatory as yet in Saddle Seat or Western classes but they are recommended. Approved headgear is mandatory in all over fences classes. Hunt Seat on the flat must wear approved helmets complete with harness. "Note: A helmet is required in Hunt Seat Equitation as per EC rules. Juniors are strongly advised to wear helmets until just before they enter the show ring in any division. All Breed Juniors must wear a helmet EC Rule A802.6
- 23. Hors Concour is allowed, unless specific breed rules indicate otherwise -- exception Dressage and Hunter Over Fences. Biosecurity guidelines at a Horse Show Make sure your horse is healthy, up to date on vaccinations, and fit for travel and competition. This starts at home, long before the show. Clean and disinfect the stall(s) your horse will use at the show. Leftover manure, shavings, and dirty walls are potential hazards. Remove all remains of bedding, and then let soap and water work on the walls. For added measure, you can rinse with a 1:15 ratio of bleach to water. Take responsibility for your horse – be his advocate. It's perfectly fine to ask someone not to touch your horse. Respect your fellow competitors and owners as well by not smooching or scratching their horses. <u>Monitor your horse's temperature</u>. Most horses will appear totes normal with a fever long before the fever makes them appear ill. Twice daily at shows is a good idea, and continue the twice daily for a bit after a show and travel. Don't share. I know this is contrary to every Sesame Street episode, but diseases are contagious! If you have extra things in your trailer that you could lend out without needing it back, you may be OK. But it's a hard pass on sharing brushes, some skin infections are contagious via brushes. Hoses that are shared among horses can also be a source of infection, so bring your own. If your horse is the most social creature on the planet, it's going to be a rude awakening when you explain to him that nose-to-nose contact is off the menu. It's fine to get him a stuffed animal instead situate your horse so he can still see other horses, but maybe at a distance. Tack stalls are great to put between horse stalls at shows. If you are concerned about biosecurity at a show, talk to your veterinarian and the Show Management,

All equines entering in Equestrian Canada sanctioned competitions as of 2020

WHAT?

- Equine Influenza Vaccination
- Equine Herpes Virus 1 & 4 Vaccination

WHEN?

- Primary vaccinations must be given in accordance with manufacturer recommendations
- Boosters vaccinations must be provided annually (every 12 months) thereafter
- Vaccination must be administered within 6 months (plus 21 days) of ARRIVING at the competition
- BUT NOT within 7 days (1 week before) of arrival to the competition
- MAKE A PLAN WITH YOUR VET!

HOW?

- EC will require that all responsible persons must declare compliance with vaccination requirements on their entry form
- Individual competitions can require proof of vaccination
